Area Command Team 1 in FEMA Region 6

Strategic Direction and Objectives

The primary responsibility of Area Command Team 1 is to organize and direct assigned resources for efficient and effective support of emergency hurricane relief activities within the framework of the National Response Plan. Our main objective is to complement and support the states in providing emergency assistance. Tasks will be developed from mission assignments that originate with FEMA. Agency fiscal policies will be followed in the conduct of mission assignment support and implementation. Mission assignments compromising safety of incident personnel or agency controlled assets will not be conducted.

Basic Operating Guidelines

- Safety of incident personnel and the public is of paramount importance in Area Command Team 1 areas of operation – support and Mission assignments that compromise safety of incident personnel or agency controlled assets will not be conducted unless risks and hazards can be mitigated.
- Area Command will establish priorities and allocate critical resources based on National Response Plan priorities and USFS IMT input.
- If the Area Commander is unavailable, the Assistant for Logistics, or the Assistant for Plans will act on his behalf.
- Area Command will concur with IMT demob plans. Demobilization and reassignment of resources will be implemented through normal operating procedures and be consistent with mission objectives and FEMA priorities. Area Command will approve release of critical resources and coordinate the transition of Incident Management Teams.
- Direct Communication between Area Command and assigned incident and logistic management teams will be maintained. Notify Area Command immediately when significant events occur.

Detailed Status Summary of Mission Assignments
In Support of FEMA Region 6

New Orleans Airport **Keith Jenkins (NC T2 IMT)**

FEMA MA: Establish Base Camp with sleeping, hygiene, and feeding with hydration for 500 federal responders located at New Orleans Airport. Food services and hydration services are to support 24-hour operations.

NOTES FROM INCIDENT STATUS SUMMARY (ICS 209)

Objectives: Continue base camp operations and other assistance as needed. Continue implementation of protection and relocation action plan. Continue to assess needs for resources and demobilize any excess resources.

Remarks: One caterer providing approximately 831 breakfasts, 1175 lunches and 1196 dinners. To date over 122876 meals have been provided in the last 20 days, Two shower units using 10,000 gallons of water per day, providing hot showers for approximately 700 people per day. One on-site laundry service, providing clean laundry to 200-300 people per day. We are providing laundry for some military also. Three sleeping areas (45,178 square feet of air-conditioned tent space) capable of sleeping 1000 people total. Space committed to date is approximately 10%. One covered dining area currently, approximately 90'x 300' capable of seating 1000 people. 18 uniformed Law Enforcement Officers (LEOs). IMT LEOs have provided base camp information, gate and parking lot security along with escorts to non-military personnel (particularly to supply vehicles both entering and exiting the base camp. Solid Waste Disposal facilities: 5 - 30 cubic yard dumpsters emptied every two days. One diesel refueling station for base camp equipment (providing fuel for caterers and others) 100 portable-johns on site Three camp crews (30 people working) Communication Equipment including: Two repeaters (one for Law Enforcement and the other for Air Ops) 20 cell phones 225 common frequency handheld radios 12 telephone lines Internet web service for IMT and EOC Other radio and other electronic communication technical assistance as needed Other: Providing logistical support and technical advice in support of helicopters operations with the New Orleans Fire Department On-site GIS assistance in cooperation with military and other agencies Other assistance to contractors, local, state and other federal agencies as needed

Hammond Distribution **Mark Stanford (TX T2 IMT)**

FEMA MA: Set up and run Base Camp to support federal responders. Base camp operations are to include, but not limited to: feeding, billeting, showers, and onsite laundry. The IMT will provide a Buying Team to support the Base Camp. The IMT will manage a state distribution system to run all distribution points and staging areas.

NOTES FROM INCIDENT STATUS SUMMARY (ICS 209)

Objectives: The National Guard will assume responsibility for the operations at Hammond R&D Center. The National Guard will continue to operate the Harahan RSA. The Texas Forest Service Lone Star State IMT, in unified command with the National Guard and Louisiana Department of Agriculture and Forestry, will continue to provide logistical support for 13 Points of Distribution and many Drop Points, in addition to supporting operations at ICPs and Base Camps. Principal commodities to be distributed include water, ice, and MREs. Commodity distribution operations will continue in areas north of Lake Pontchartrain to people who do not have the means to travel to Point of Distribution sites. Operations to locate households and communities that have not received assistance will continue. Contingency planning for Hurricane Rita will continue.

Remarks: Since 9/3/03, 902,666 people have received commodities. Specific commodity distribution counts for 9/19/05 include: Water, 26 trucks; 425 since 9/3/05. Ice, 21 trucks; 316 since 9/3/05. MREs, 23; 272 since 9/3/05. 18,552 vehicles and 1058 walk-ins were served today; 293,403 vehicles and 22,457 walk-ins since 9/3/05. Parishes severely impacted include: Orleans, Plaquemines, Jefferson, Lafourche, St. Charles, St. John the Baptist, St. Bernard, St. Tammany, Washington, and Tangipahoa. Costs do not include FEMA contract equipment and land and billing

use agreements. Costs include bus transportation and meals for the National Guard. The Committed Resources table includes 1,700 National Guard.

St Gabriel Disaster Mortuary Support Camp Ken Paul (OR/CA T2 IMT)

FEMA MA: Support facility management, feeding, and logistics needs of the Disaster Mortuary (DMORT) facility at 6015 Iberville Road, St. Gabriel, Louisiana.

NOTES FROM INCIDENT STATUS SUMMARY (ICS 209)

Objectives: ORCA Team Ken Paul IC is providing support for both the Louisiana Interagency Emergency Support Base and St Gabriel Disaster Mortuary Support Camp. Camp operations include, feeding, billeting, showers, and laundry for the DMORT organization, as well as facilitating the planning process.

Remarks: Continue to provide logistical support and facilitate planning process for the Disaster Mortuary Operational Response Team. FEMA Information Officers are handling all DMORT inquiries from the media and public. DMORT, CBP, FBI, and the Iberville Parish Sheriff and St Gabriel Police continue to fill vital roles. Camp facilities are being expanded to accommodate the DMORT Operation. Evacuation and contingency plans have been completed for the support personnel.

San Antonio Displaced Persons Support Mark Mullenix (RM T2 IMT)

FEMA MA: Provide planning, organizational, and logistical support/assistance to the City of San Antonio, Emergency Management, in receiving and supporting bringing evacuees from Hurricane Katrina in to Kelly Air Force Base, San Antonio, Texas.

NOTES FROM INCIDENT STATUS SUMMARY (ICS 209)

Objectives: Continue to provide an array of services, including food, clothing, sanitation, medical, dental, mental health, and social services. Contingency planning is ongoing for tropical storm Rita and future storm systems. The San Antonio Police Department is transitioning security services to a private security company, but will retain jurisdiction. Accelerated consolidation of shelters and placement of Katrina evacuees in long term housing in anticipation of additional evacuees from tropical storm Rita.

Remarks: Demobilization of timed out crews and overhead is continuing. The San Antonio Police Department, Red Cross, and Salvation Army are included in Committed Resources under "OTHER". There are currently 2931 evacuees in 4 shelters and an additional 294 individuals in local special needs shelters.

LA Interagency Emergency Support Base, Baton Rouge Ken Paul (OR/CA T2 IMT)

FEMA MA: Assist with standing up Louisiana State Fire Service Mutual Aid system and provide support for coordination and support of mutual aid assistance at Louisiana State University, Baton Rouge, in cooperation with the IAFC.

NOTES FROM INCIDENT STATUS SUMMARY (ICS 209)

Objectives: ORCA Team, Ken Paul IC, is providing support for both the Louisiana Interagency Support Base and the St Gabriel Disaster Mortuary Support Base. Base Camp operations include, feeding, billeting, showers, and laundry for emergency response personnel.

Remarks: Currently staging: 3 catering units, 2 laundry services, 1 shower unit, and Task Force #92. Evacuation and contingency plans have been developed for the support staff. Four water tenders and Task Force #93 are expected to arrive in PM of 9/20/05. Continuing to evaluate location and capacity of camp.

Jackson Support Camp, New Orleans Jim Krugman (CA T1 IMT)

FEMA MA: Set up and run Base Camp to support federal responders. Base Camp operations are to include, but not limited to: feeding, billeting, showers, and onsite laundry. The IMT will provide a Buying Team to support the Base Camp. The camp will support 2500 people.

NOTES FROM INCIDENT STATUS SUMMARY (ICS 209)

Objectives: Continue the support of emergency personnel at the Jackson Support Base, West Bank Water Purification plant satellite camp, Carrolton Water Purification Plant, New Orleans FDHQ, 500 city workers at the I.C.E. base and the National Guard located at the New Orleans Convention Center.

Remarks: Total meals served yesterday was 13,588. Jackson Support Base provided approximately 1300 breakfasts, 4000 lunches, and 1800 dinners yesterday. West Bank Water Purification satellite camp provided 435 breakfasts, 600 lunches, 503 dinners yesterday. Feeding at the New Orleans Convention Center included approximately 1970 breakfasts, 1000 lunches and 1975 dinners. Additional logistical support for showers, laundry service, water and ice is being provided to all the satellite locations listed in block 39. Total number of personnel supported approximately 8000.

Camp Beauregard Distribution Dick Gormley (SW T2 IMT)

FEMA MA: Set up and run Base Camp to support federal responders. Base camp operations are to include, but not limited to: feeding, billeting, showers, and onsite laundry. The IMT will provide a Buying Team to support the Base Camp.

NOTES FROM INCIDENT STATUS SUMMARY (ICS 209)

Objectives: Supply distribution continuing 24 hours per day to affected areas. Transloading operations continue at commercial warehouse.

Remarks: Approximately 4,330 incoming truckloads processed since 8/28/05. Fuel depot has pumped approximately 212,478 gallons since 9/4/05. Providing lodging for 20 firefighters for the Kisatchie NF. Personnel count does not include truckers, contractors, or other agency personnel (estimated 600) not under direct control of CWIMT. 13th Army Combat Support continues to track receiving of trucks at downstream distribution points.

Barksdale AFB Mobilization Troy Floyd (SA T2 IMT)

FEMA MA: Assist FEMA and all cooperators working the Barksdale AFB MOB Center with receiving, distribution, and logistics.

NOTES FROM INCIDENT STATUS SUMMARY (ICS 209)

Objectives: Barksdale AFB food services continue feeding truckers and incident personnel. 20K forklift delivered today in order to download FEMA pods off of long haul drivers, warehouse operations has been temporarily suspended due to Air Force operational inspections. Warehouse operations will continue at 1900 tonight.

Remarks: Assist FEMA with mob center. Continue warehouse cross-loading operations of commodities onto FEMA lease trailers. Manage the truck staging area. Provide logistical support for FEMA and all cooperators assigned to mob center. Receive up to 100 DMORT reefer trailers. Transload water and tarps as lease empties arrive at mob center. 24-hour warehouse operations will continue. Manage gate security in and out of Barksdale mob center. Provide up to 600 meals for truck driver and incident personnel.

Holy Cross Support Camp Bob Anderson/Bob Sweeny/Richard Hampton (T1 IMT)

FEMA MA: Provide logistical and planning support to the New Orleans Fire Department.

Texarkana Trailer Staging Mike Hayes (LMT)

FEMA MA: Provide Logistics Management Team to provide resource tracking for trailers at Texarkana. Housing units will be received at staging area, prepared for deployment and issued to the Recovery Division for placement in group lots and individual lots. The logistics personnel should be prepared to support a 24 hour operation working 12 hour shifts.

Baton Rouge Trailer Staging Bill Easterling (LMT)

FEMA MA: Provide Logistics Management Team to provide resource tracking for trailers at Baton Rouge. Housing units will be received at staging area, prepared for deployment and issued to the Recovery Division for placement in group lots and individual lots. The logistics personnel should be prepared to support a 24 hour operation working 12 hour shifts.

Saints Field USAR Support Carl West (CA T1 IMT)

FEMA MA: Incident Management Team to support Urban Search and Recovery operations by establishing support camp near New Orleans Saints practice field, 6000 Airline Highway, Metairie, LA.

NOTES FROM INCIDENT STATUS SUMMARY (ICS 209)

Objectives: CIIMT 2 (Molumby) shadowed by Northwest-Oregon IMT Team (West). City of New Orleans is under an evacuation ordered by the mayor due to impending threat of Hurricane Rita.

Remarks: Transfer of command from CIIMT 2 (Molumby) to Northwest Oregon (West) to occur at 0600 hrs. Continue planning and logistical support to FEMA IST Blue. Saint Support Base currently has 1255 USAR & Military personnel.

Lacombe Support Camp Curtis Heaton

FEMA MA: Establish and manage base camp with a capacity of 1000 for federal emergency personnel, local police and fire, Red Cross and National Guard. Off-site meals are provided to staff and patients of Louisiana Heart hospital.
