



## Incident Response to Terrorist Bombings (IRTB)

IRTB prepares first responders to react effectively, work cooperatively, and apply countermeasures in any incident involving explosives. This course is **FREE** of charge.

## Scope of Course

- **Course Introduction** describes course background, purpose, content, manner of presentation and standards of behavior in the classroom, on the ranges and in the community.
- **Terrorism and Energetic Materials** identifies potential terrorist bombing targets and describes pre-attack indicators and tactics and techniques likely to be used during attacks on those targets.
- **Introduction to Energetic Materials** describes components, interactions and physical phenomena associated with explosive events.
- **Recognition of Energetic Materials, Devices and Device Components** recognizes explosive and incendiary materials, devices and device components.
- **Responding to Pre-detonation Incidents** specifies actions required to direct and participate in a safe and effective response to pre-detonation incidents.
- **Responding to Post-detonation Incidents** specifies actions required to direct and participate in a safe and effective response to a post-detonation incident.
- **Responding to Special Situations** describes how to adjust normal response policies, procedures and tactics during special situations to produce safe and effective operational responses.
- **Case Study** covers recent Weapons of Mass Destruction (WMD) incidents and lessons learned from the responding agencies.

## Prevention of and Response to Suicide Bombing Incidents (PRSBI)

PRSBI provides senior state, tribal and local emergency responders with the knowledge and skills needed to develop policies for the prevention, interdiction, response, and mitigation of a suicide bombing attack. This course is **FREE** of charge.

This four hour course will be held from **1300-1700 on 29 April 2015** at the **Montgomery Police Department Training Facility** located at **5880 Old Hayneville Road, Montgomery, AL**.

This course is open to all **police, fire and medical first responders**.

### Scope of Course

- **Defining the Suicide Bombing Threat** provides an historic overview of suicide bombing, characteristics of a suicide bomber, and how emergency organizations can disrupt a terrorist's ability to carry out a suicide bombing.
- **Infrastructure Protection, Risk Management, and Critical Asset Assessment** identifies the importance of conducting these assessments within a jurisdiction.
- **Basic Explosives and Characteristics** focuses on the energetic materials used by suicide bombers. Basic terms, concepts, and explosive characteristics are discussed in preparation for the field laboratories.
- **Case Studies** analyzes course concepts as applied to actual suicide bombing incidents.
- **Suicide Bombing Devices** familiarizes participants with suicide bombing improvised explosive devices (IEDs) and accessories used in the production or use of IEDs.
- **Threat Assessments** provides worksheets that assist participants in accurately assessing local and regional threat levels. Participants develop a threat assessment of an adversary known to use suicide bombing as a tactic.
- **Vulnerability Assessments** supplies information on the importance of conducting these assessments in order to develop scaled countermeasures appropriate to the threat. A practical exercise is included.
- **Pre-Attack/Imminent Attack Countermeasures, Issues and Responses** presents information, techniques, and practical examples of physical, procedural, staffing and operational countermeasures that can be implemented.
- **Risk Analysis** provides information on the importance of conducting a risk analysis based on asset, threat, and vulnerability assessments to assist in comparing and selecting effective countermeasures.
- **Post-blast Issues and Responses** provides policy guidance, as well as experience-based practical knowledge, on what to do in the aftermath of a suicide bombing.

## **Homemade Explosive: Awareness, Recognition and Response (HME)**

- Recognize homemade explosive processing equipment, and Improvised explosive devices, or IEDs, and their components
- Apply legal principles to determine probable cause and identify appropriate use of force options in suicide bombing incidents
