Overview:

If an event occurs in which the Strategic National Stockpile (SNS) has to be accessed by the State of Alabama, health professionals and others should be familiar with the SNS and how to respond when received.

The SNS training course will benefit a variety of health professionals including pharmacists, pharmacy technicians, nurses, social workers, mental health personnel, emergency management personnel, immunization personnel, educators, and others.

Course Objectives:

- Describe the purpose and goals of Strategic National Stockpile (SNS).
- List and understand each of the job actions in a Point of Dispensing (POD).
- Describe the sequence of progression through a POD site.
- Explain the roles and responsibilities of pharmacists, nurses, and social workers in a POD.

Training Activities Include:

- Plenary session providing a general overview of the SNS for all participants.
- Demonstration and exercise of a POD site.
- In-depth presentations explaining the roles and responsibilities in a POD.
