

SPORTS AND SPECIAL EVENTS INCIDENT MANAGEMENT (MGT404)

Sept. 30th. - Oct. 1st. 2014



This course emphasizes the unique aspects of response to an incident occurring during a sports/ special events, including considerations for business continuity and after-action activities. You will learn the skills necessary to effectively manage an incident by applying and implementing a multi-disciplinary management team approach as described in the National Incident Management System (NIMS).

The course is designed to help develop athletic department staff, facility management personnel, campus public safety personnel, emergency response supervisors, and others involved in sports/special events management to better manage incidents that could occur

during an event.

The course concludes with a practical application and role-play exercise. It provides specific emphasis on incident action planning and resource management processes.

Prerequisites:

The following must be completed prior to registering for this course.

- National Incident Management System/incident command system training
- ICS for Single Resources
- Initial Action Incidents (IS-200.b) or equivalent basic incident command system training

- Resource Management Process
- Incident Management for Sports/Special Event
- Multi-disciplinary Management Approach
- National Incident Management System (NIMS)
- Business Continuity Considerations
- After Action Reporting
- Incident Action Planning
